A1 Elkesley Junctions Improvement Scheme

We write to advise you of the upcoming full closures of the A1 southbound carriageway. These closures are required whilst surfacing works are carried out to re-profile the carriageway to a new alignment and lift the carriageway up to the new levels. The road level will be raised by over 800mm in places which cannot be done safely in the space available with traffic running.

We apologise for any disruption these works cause and we thank you for your continued patience. In order to minimise disruption we will attempt to reduce the noise from these activities and will also seek to carry out as much of the noisiest activities during the day as possible, or away from the village at night.

The southbound A1 road will be closed at Apleyhead Junction with the signed diversion for local traffic via A614 Blyth Road, A616 Ollerton Road, A616 Back Lane, A616 Wellow Road, A616 Newark Road, A616 Ollerton Road, A616 Great North Road and A46 to re-join the A1. We expect this route to be very congested and in order to reduce the flows we will also be advising long distance traffic from north of the M18 to use the M18, M1 and re-join the A1 at the A52 Nottingham.

Access to and from Elkesley village and Forest Road will be possible via the northbound carriageway from Twyford junction (Dover Bottom B6387, Gamston).
